Combustible Dust Management Assessment Comments:

Bit of a rocky start with the pre-tour meeting as many wanted to know if SAFER Advisors would submit reports to WorkSafeBC; assured that the inspection was a systems inspection rather than a regulatory inspection; followed through with pre-meeting guideline speaking points and thought that everyone now understands the role of the SAFER Combustible Dust Advisor; mill was generally very clean; some primary dust surrounding a couple of conveyor tail drums; main production floor work stations are free of any significant primary dust build-ups; tops of operator booth have some secondary dust and is considered insignificant – supervisor noted that booths are cleaned every graveyard shift; filing room had some secondary dust under bandsaws in saw storage area but not near any grinders or ignition sources; checked for magnets in filing room dust extraction system; generally a clean mill with no real concerns with regard to combustible dust.
